Bob Evans Homestead Museum

The Homestead was home to the Evans family for nearly 20 years. Built in the early 1820s, the Homestead had served as a stagecoach stop and inn. Now it serves as a museum dedicated to the legacy of Bob Evans Restaurants and its role in Gallia County.



Appalachian Crafts Cabin

Built in 1880 from pine, poplar, and oak which grew right here in Gallia County.



Ohio Historical Marker 18-27 This official Ohio Historical Marker honors the life and work of

Robert "Bob" Evans.



Freedom Seekers Cabin

One of many cabins built to house the 100 freed slaves who came to the area in 1805.



Our Hero Mural Recognizes the service and sacrifices of the heroes in every branch of the U.S. Military.



Bob Evans Event Barn

Dating back to the early 20th century, this barn was used by students at Rio Grande College as a dairy cattle and sheep barn. Purchased by Bob Evans in 1953, it continued to house dairy cattle and sheep. The barn is now utilized as an event venue.



Ohio Historical Marker 19-27 This official Ohio Historical Marker observes the significant role the Homestead played in Ohio History.



Ingles Schoolhouse

The schoolhouse was built in 1860 and served as a school until 1918. It was also used as a general store, residence, and even a barn.



Ohio Historical Marker 20-27 This official Ohio Historical Marker recognizes the Adamsville settlement of 1804 by Revolutionary War Veteran Adam Rickabaugh.



Ohio Bicentennial Barn

Originally built in the mid 1840's. The Ohio Bicentennial logo was painted in 1999 to commemorate the 200th anniversary of Ohio's admission to the union in 1803.
